Enrolling in Catalyst Pathways®: Next Steps for Physician and Patient

- Review and complete the Enrollment Form. The enrollment form is available via YourCatalystPathways.com (click the "Get Started" button) and must be reviewed and completed by both the physician and patient.
 - **IMPORTANT:** Both pages 1 and 2 of the form must be signed by the physician and patient for the patient to be eligible for Catalyst Pathways services and financial programs
 - The physician is required to fax the signed Enrollment Form along with patient's insurance card (front and back) to Catalyst Pathways at 1-833-422-8260.
- The patient's Care Coordinator will contact the patient first. Once the completed and signed Enrollment Form is returned to Catalyst Pathways, a Care Coordinator will contact the patient about next steps, including:
 - Benefits investigation
 - Prior authorization and/or appeal
 - Working with the physician if a claim is denied
 - Referral to a financial assistance program provided by a LEMS advocacy foundation
- A Patient Access Liaison (PAL) will contact the patient after the Care Coordinator. Each patient will be assigned a PAL who will reach out to them via phone to schedule an in-person or phone meeting to discuss:
 - Insurance coverage
 - The Catalyst Pathways Welcome Kit
 - LEMS support programs and other resources available
- AnovoRx Specialty Pharmacy will contact the patient. The pharmacist will schedule delivery of the medicine to the patient through the mail. They will call the patient prior to shipping the medicine to ensure that all mailing information is correct and that someone will be home to accept the delivery the next day. All patients should take their medicine as directed by their physician.
